CAMPER SCHOLARSHIPS

RMMC has a Scholarship Fund available for summer resident, wilderness, and family camp participants. The goal of the scholarship fund is to ensure that finances are not a barrier to enjoying a summer camp experience. We offer 25% - 50% off the registration fee based on the need of the camper(s).

This summer RMMC will be coordinating van transportation from Hesston, Kansas to/from camp. Campers can add the option of this transportation while registering online or by calling us. The RMMC board has decided to offer scholarship assistance for the coordinated transportation to/from Kansas. The cost of round trip transportation is \$95 per camper or \$50 one way. For 8&9 Grade Resident Camp in 2010, 70% of our campers came from Kansas. For our other resident camp weeks in 2010, 20% - 40% of the campers hailed from Kansas. This van transportation is a great benefit to our camp in making it possible for kids to come from farther distances to attend camp in the Rockies.

Thanks to Ted Stuckey and Hesston Mennonite Church for their years of assistance and support with this van transportation. Continued thanks to Jim Mason and the numerous drivers for their part in making it possible for kids to experience summer camp at RMMC.
